What We Look For in First-Time Freshman Applicants

There is not a formula to determine your admissibility to St. Bonaventure University. The admission committee reviews each applicant's qualifications individually, considering a variety of characteristics that indicate academic preparation and potential for success. In order to make the best admission decision possible, St. Bonaventure University requires both an academic recommendation form and a 250-word minimum untimed writing sample of all full-time degree-seeking undergraduate applicants.

Normal course preparation for most incoming freshmen includes three years of math, three years of science, four years of history (social studies), two years of language and four years of English. Your admission is based on evidence of potential for successful study, given the following criteria: curriculum related to rigor of program and grades achieved in secondary school, standardized test scores, extracurricular activities and recommendations.
